10:00 – THE OLD STONE FORT 1772 <https://theoldstonefort.org>

The Stone Fort, the 1780 Ingold-Schaeffer Dutch Barn, the 1786 Hartmann's Dorf House

Constructed in 1772 as a High Dutch (German) Reformed church. In the Revolutionary War, the church was fortified in 1777 with a surrounding log stockade, known as the Lower Fort, one of three defensive forts along the Schoharie River. On October 17, 1780, a force of approximately 800 Loyalists and Native American allies led by Sir John Johnson and Mohawk Captain Joseph Brant raided the Schoharie Valley. The fort was briefly attacked. A cannonball hole remains visible in the rear cornice of the building.

These times are approximate-

11:45- The STOLZENBURG BARN ca. 1790 152 Stolzenburg Road

Rt 30 south to Prospect St (1B) to Rickard Hill Rd (1B) to right on Abrams Rd. to Stolzenburg Road.

1:00- THE BECKER STONE HOUSE ca 1772 119 Murphy Road [Becker Stone House Historical Marker](#)

Left onto Abrams Rd to the end, right onto Mill St, quick left onto Murphy Rd to end, house on right and the Gas Up on the left. Please park in designated area for festival.

Built for Maj. Joseph Becker, of an early Palatine family, who survived an attack by Tories and Mohawks in 1782 by sheltering in and defending the stone house. His brother and others were caught out in their fields, and killed and scalped.

Back to Rt. 30 south to left on Spring St, left on Warner Hill Rd, first building on left.
